Homestead Hill is a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program of Bardenhagen Berries farm, located in the heart of Leelanau County. Signing up for a CSA membership with our farm is a great way to commit your household to eating more fruits and vegetables. Just \$31/week brings you FRESH, LOCAL GOODNESS that we hope will leave you looking forward to the next week! 2019 OPTIONS

Spring Treat (April & May)

Tantalize your taste buds with the extra early green goodness from our hoop house and field. Enjoy leafy greens, succulent radishes, micro-greens, and scallions followed by asparagus. Receive 3-4 items per week. Deciding between Regular and Small? An example of unit size for the Regular share is 10 oz of salad greens vs 5 oz for the Small share.

- ❖ **Regular Spring Treat (6 Weeks)** \$132 (avg. \$22/week).
- ❖ **Small Size (6 Weeks)** 50-60% of size of the regular share. May include fewer items than Regular size. \$85

Summer Garden Shares (early June thru September)

This is the heart of what we do! Real food for you and your family. You'll receive all the traditional garden staples, but with a sense of style and adventure beyond what you would find in the typical grocery cart! We plant over a hundred varieties, ranging from delectable heirlooms to our "tried and true" favorites. Expect to find tomatoes and cucumbers weeks ahead of in your backyard! We carefully pick, wash, and pack your weekly share of 6-10 items, based on what's in season and ready for harvest. Grown using organic methods. Choose the option that fits you best!

- ❖ **16 Week Regular Summer Share** Our most popular option! \$499 (avg. \$31/wk)
- ❖ **16 Week Small Summer Share** 50-60% of size of the Regular Share. \$310 (avg. \$19/week)
- ❖ **16 Week Large Summer Share** The same as a Regular Share, but 50-60% larger! \$750
- ❖ **8 Week Peak Season Regular Summer Share** The same as a Regular Share, but only during July and August. \$280
- ❖ **8 Week Peak Season Small Summer Share** The same as a Small Share, but only during July and August. \$175
- ❖ **8 Week Peak Season Large Share** The same as a Large share, but only during July and August. \$415

Fruit Shares from Bardenhagen Berries

Available to those signing up for any vegetable or flower summer share. For six weeks, from mid-June to late July, receive either strawberries or cherries grown on the farm (depending on what is ripe). Conventionally grown, not organic.

- ❖ **Regular Fruit Share:** 1 quart each week. \$30
- ❖ **Large Fruit Share:** 2 quarts each week. \$60

Flower Shares

- ❖ **12 Week Bouquet Share** Treat yourself or someone you love with fresh-cut seasonal flowers, grown by us on our farm! Starting in late June, receive one bouquet of our best blooms every week! \$135
- ❖ **8 Week Peak Season Bouquet Share** Same as the 12 Week Share, but limited to July and August. \$100
- ❖ **8 Week Peak Season DIY Flower Bucket Share** Like to arrange flowers? With this option, you'll receive 35+ stems each week, consisting of enough flowers and foliage for you to arrange approximately 2-3 bouquets). \$240

Fall Garden Shares (October & November)

- ❖ **8 Week Regular Fall Share** The days may be cooler and the days shorter, but we will keep the harvest going for you! Shares contain a variety of crops ranging from hoop house salad greens & herbs to storage crops like potatoes, onions, carrots, and winter squash. \$249 (avg. \$31/week).
- ❖ **8 Week Small Size Fall Share** 50-60% of size of the Regular Fall Share. \$154 (avg. \$19/week).
- ❖ **Every Other Week (EOW) Regular Fall Share (4 Boxes)** Same as Regular but limited to every other week. \$144

Winter Veggies & Greens (December thru March)

For the first time, we hope to offer a limited number of monthly CSA boxes of vegetables from December 2019 through March 2020. Offerings will be announced in our email newsletter and on our website. (Sign up in Sept-Oct of 2019.)
