HOMESTEAD HILL CSA

Homestead Hill is a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program of Bardenhagen Berries farm, located in the heart of Leelanau County. Signing up for a CSA membership with our farm is a great way to commit your household to eating more fruits and vegetables. Just \$32/week brings you FRESH, LOCAL GOODNESS that we hope will leave you looking forward to the next week! 2021 OPTIONS

I. Summer Vegetable Shares (starting early June)

This is the heart of what we do! Real food for you and your family. You'll receive all the traditional garden staples, but with a sense of style and adventure beyond what you would find in the typical grocery cart! We plant over a hundred varieties, ranging from delectable heirlooms to our "tried and true" favorites. Expect to find tomatoes and cucumbers weeks ahead of in your backyard! We carefully pick, wash, and pack your weekly share of 6-10 items, based on what is in season and ready for harvest. Grown using organic methods. The share season starts the second week of June and runs for either 16 or 20 weeks depending on your preference. We also offer a shorter "Peak Season" share that runs for 9 weeks in July and August.

Choose the option that fits you best! Deciding between Regular and Small? An example of unit size for the Regular share is 8 oz of salad greens vs 5 oz for the Small share, or ½ lb of green beans vs. ¾ lb. If the size turns out to not be a good fit after the first week or two, we are happy to adjust your share size and cost accordingly.

- **Small Share.** 50-60% of size of the Regular Share. (Avg. \$20 per week. Good fit for households of 1-2 light veggie eaters.)
- **Regular Share.** Our most popular option! (Avg. \$32 per week. Good fit for most households of 2-4.)
- **Large Share.** The same as a Regular Share, but 50-60% larger! (avg. \$47 per week. Good fit for households of 2-4 that are serious vegetable eaters and/or do a lot of entertaining.)

II. ADD-ON OPTIONS

Available to those signing up for any vegetable summer share.

A) Fruit Shares from Bardenhagen Berries

Runs six weeks from mid-June to late July. Receive either strawberries or cherries grown on the farm (depending on what is ripe). Conventionally grown, not organic.

Choose either Regular (1 quart/week) OR Large (2 quarts/week)

B) Flower Shares

Treat yourself or someone you love with fresh-cut seasonal flowers, grown by us on our farm!

Choose either the 12 Week Bouquet Share (Starting in late June) OR, Peak Season Bouquet Share (9 bouquets in July & August).

C) Spring Treat Share

Tantalize your taste buds with the extra early green goodness from our hoop house and field. Enjoy leafy greens (lettuce, chard, kale, spinach), succulent radishes, micro-greens, and herbs. Receive 3-4 items per week. Runs for 6 weeks from April 22nd thru May 27th. Limited availability. If signing up after February 15th, check our website or contact us first to confirm availability. Order two shares for double the goodness! Thursday pickups only.

One size available.

D) Winter Share

The days may be cooler and the days shorter, but we will keep the harvest going for you! This 8 Week Share runs for the months of November and December and features a variety of crops ranging from hoop house salad greens & herbs to storage crops like potatoes, celeriac, onions, carrots, and winter squash. Thursday pickups only.

Choose Small, Regular, or Large.
